Important Notes/Dates:

- Expect one training day off following most 3 day competitions. Vacations are best planned before or over the winter break or directly following the February competition. Please let your coach know well ahead of time if you plan to miss practice.
- Pre Season (Summer Camp) training at MRU is a mandatory part of the program for all athletes level U12 and up. U10 and Novice athletes are welcome to register but it is optional.
- First Day of Training - September 3 or 4 for Novice and older, September 5 or 9 for Precompetitive and U10
- Thanksgiving Weekend - Sunday and Monday, October 13-14, 2024 - No Training
- Winter Break - No Training December 20, 2024 through January 2, 2025. Training to resume January 3, 2025 for Novice Silver, January 5 for U10/Novice Black/U12/Youth and January 6 for Pre Competitive.
- Family Day Long Weekend/Easter Weekend - Provincial Stream will train due the competition the following weekend. Hours may differ and we will give time off depending on pool availability.
- Last Day of Training - May 4, 2025

³ Pre Competitive teams will participate in the NS send off show on May 1, rather than the spring watershow. They are welcome to attend the synchro sister event on May 4th

- Provincial Team 2025 - The SYNC competition is planned to be in Calgary July 14-20, 2025

Program Information

- Team selections will be in September. Athletes will be evaluated for both water and land skills. Teams will be selected according to testing results, coachability and work ethic during the team selection process. U12/Novice Tues/Thurs athletes will be split into two groups from September 3rd through 19th during team selections. This will be communicated to families by mid August for planning purposes.
- Duet and solo practices are additional to team practices. A separate solo and duet try out will be held in September. This is an optional program that athletes can try out for. Not all athletes that request a duet/solo will receive one. Athletes can also choose to participate in extra figures practices at an additional cost. Duet/Solo practices will run on a weeknight when swimmers do not have team practice. Solos are not an option at the U10 level.
- Programs will include pool and dryland sessions. Dryland sessions may include (but not limited to) flexibility training, strength, ballet, gymnastics, team landrill, sport psychology, etc.
- As Artistic Swimming is a team sport, we expect athletes to be at all practices except in cases of injury, illness or bereavement.
